Terms to be accepted in consideration of Covid-19 threat:

- The guaranteed prizepool of €10'000 is effective only in case our expected core markets (namely Finland, Latvia and Lithuania) have not raised again governmental restrictions for travelling to/from Estonia including quarantine requirements.
- In an unlikely situation where any of the 3 core markets become affected from new travelling restrictions, it's treated as force majeure for tournament organizer and organizer re-evaluates the possible new guaranteed prizepool. Organizer commits to act in a good will, might these circumstances arise.
- Organizer commits to €5000 guaranteed prizepool even if all core markets get travel restrictions.
- Tournament organizer reserves rights to cancel the tournament due to force majeure in an unlikely situation if Estonian government would set any new restrictions that make organizing the event impossible.
